



COVID-19 Provider Surge Onboarding

Minimum Provider Recruitments

- Valid, state-issued medical license in good standing
- US trained, board-certified
- Minimum 3 years of professional post-residency experience in direct patient care
- Emergency, Family Medicine, or Internal Medicine preferred. Specialized Medicine acceptable as long as the provider still practices clinically in a Primary/Urgent Care setting.

Licensure Priority

- Priority volume states: TX, CA, NY, GA, IL, OH, MA, MO, MI
- Anthem States: CA, CO, CT, GA, IN, KY, ME, MT, NV, NY, OH, VA, WI
- Multiple state licenses preferred
- Desire a minimum of 12 hours/week in 4 hour shifts
 - Shifts are: 11-3pm EST, 3-7pm EST, 7-11pm EST.

Onboarding Process

- Physician must provide all documentation to K Health and credentialed individually (2-3 days)
- K Health Affiliated PC will provide individual physicians with contract within 1 day
- Training and onboarding scheduled within 1-2 days of contracting
- Provider is scheduled in available shifts
- Training to be provided remotely during the course of 1 hour. Materials distributed to the provider, and lead physician and support team assigned to facilitate in the onboarding process.
- Provider goes live in first possible shift
- Support team available during all times using designated communication channels

Compensation

- TBD: Our typical compensation varies by number of hours committed weekly, as well as number of licenses. It averages around \$100/hour, ranges from \$90-\$125/hour.
- K Health will be competitive across the board to bring providers onto our innovative AI-assisted telemedicine platform where no billing, coding or anything is required other than providing quality care to our users

- Provider must operate within our medical protocols “red book” and all cases will be reviewed by our lead physicians to ensure quality
